The Grid Method Answers

I can multiply using the grid method.



$12 \times 8 = \underline{\quad 96 \quad}$

x	10	2
8	80	16

$80 + 16 = 96$

$14 \times 4 = \underline{\quad 56 \quad}$

x	10	4
4	40	16

$40 + 16 = 56$

$23 \times 3 = \underline{\quad 69 \quad}$

x	20	3
3	60	9

$60 + 9 = 69$
